#### Lesson Topic: Kid's Fundraising Challenge

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#### **Lesson Objectives:**

Raise money to support a cause your classroom cares about by hosting an "Art for a Cause" Fundraiser. For more information on project options, please reference the current ADRA Kids Gift Catalog by visiting ADRA.org/kidsgiftcatalog.

#### **Materials & Equipment:**

- Drawing and coloring materials (colored pencils, markers, crayons)
- ▶ White paper or drawing sheets
- Stickers and other decorative items
- Tables and chairs
- Display boards or walls
- Donation boxes or jars
- Flyers or posters to promote the event

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#### **Kid's Fundraising Challenge**

#### Steps to Organize the Fundraiser:

- **1. Introduction**: Explain the concept of fundraising to the students. Use simple language to describe what fundraising is and why people do it. Talk about the impact of fundraising on various causes and how it helps organizations and communities in need. \*Please reference notes below on how to describe fundraising to students of varying ages.
- **2. Choose the Cause:** Discuss with the class and let them vote on an ADRA cause they want to support. It could be animals, meals for other kids, or anything else they care about.
- **3. Create Artworks:** Encourage all the students to create beautiful artworks related to the chosen cause. They can draw animals, flowers, wells or any theme that represents what they want to support.
- **4. Art Exhibition:** Set up an "Art for a Cause" exhibition at your school or a local community center. Hang the students' artworks on display boards or walls for everyone to see
- **5. Invite the Community:** Send out flyers or posters inviting parents, teachers, friends, and neighbors to the art exhibition. Let them know that the money raised will go to support the chosen cause.
- **6. Donation Boxes:** Place donation boxes or jars near each artwork with a sign explaining the cause and encouraging people to make a contribution.

- **7. Art Sale:** You can also organize an art sale where people can buy the artworks. Let the buyers know that their purchase will support the cause they care about.
- **8. Art Activities:** At the exhibition, you can have art-related activities like face painting or a coloring station for younger kids. Charge a small fee for these activities, and the money collected will also go towards the fundraiser.
- **9. Thank You Cards:** After the event, create thank-you cards with the classrooms' artwork. Send these cards to everyone who supported the fundraiser to show your gratitude.

Remember, the most important thing is to have fun and work together for a good cause. This activity will not only raise funds but also promote creativity, teamwork, and empathy in the classroom. Happy fundraising!
